Statement of the Iowa Staff Union - NSO

The Iowa Staff Union stands in solidarity with the members of National Education Association Staff Organization.

The National Education Association's lockout of NEASO employees is a failure of NEA management to treat employees with dignity and denies the NEA's 2.6 million members with access to critical communication, organizing and polling expertise as we enter our back-to-school recruitment period.

Threatening to strip employee health care benefits and going so far to send out COBRA notices is the worst type of employer coercion and gives employers everywhere a vindictive playbook to point to when they seek to crush labor actions by our members. Thankfully, a national news story shamed NEA management into changing course.

Many of our staff in Iowa have a shirt that reads: "I'm so union, even my union has a union"

We wore this shirt because we are proud to be union members that work for a labor union – we walk our talk. Now we wear this message in defiance of the NEA and its heavy-handed, anti-labor tactics.
