I am writing to urge you to quickly settle a contract with NEA staff that respects them and their critical work for our members.

I am a proud 20 year NEA member in Columbus, Ohio. My NEA membership has strengthened me throughout my career, from professional development to securing better contracts for educators that help lift our schools and help our students. NEA staff are vital to NEA. They keep membership data safe, work with Congress and the Biden Administration for better working and learning conditions, train members to become better advocates, and organize micro-credentials for us so we can succeed in our careers. We can't improve our students' learning conditions—or our own working conditions—without their expertise and dedication.

I expect our union to live our union values. Spreading misinformation, shutting workers out, and canceling benefits are union-busting techniques that undermine all working people. It is unacceptable that the nation's largest union would use these tactics against its own workers. It sets a dangerous precedent for the labor movement and for school districts across the nation.
